

Warmer Weather = More Motorcycles

As warmer weather hits more motorcyclist are now hitting the road. We need to be mindful of these cyclists and have an increased awareness of their presence, especially on HOV lanes. In Virginia Governor Tim Kaine has proclaimed May 2009 as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. "In addition to the three top reasons for motorcycle crashes in 2008 -- failure to maintain control, following too closely and exceeding the speed limit -- other situations may cause motorcycle crashes. The VAHSO reports that approximately half of all fatal motorcycle crashes involve automobiles. Many of these crashes are caused by the motorist's failure to see a motorcycle in traffic. Before pulling out into traffic, changing lanes, turning, backing up or proceeding through an intersection, drivers are urged to also look for motorcycles."

All K&K drivers need to keep this in mind while driving this summer.
