Parking along DC's Street Car Route Can Cost You.

From July 24 through Aug. 21, DC parking enforcement officers wrote 143 tickets for parking in a manner that obstructed streetcars. These tickets are costing motorists \$100.00.



The D.C. streetcar line is months from being fully operational. The line is scheduled to carry passengers down H Street running from Union Station to the Anacostia River.

Warning notices were issued for two weeks before officers began writing the \$100 tickets. Ticketing during the testing phase is necessary in order to get motorists used to sharing the road with the streetcars before they begin carrying passengers, prior to the end of the year.

Streetcar track laid in the right-hand lanes of H Street in Northeast allows vehicles to pass on the left and to park on the right. The width of parking spots are defined by a strip of white paint. Parking can be tight and if a car hangs over the white line just a hair, it will bring the entire streetcar system to a halt.

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Beware of Metro SmarTrip Card Scam

Metro is advising riders not to buy discounted (plastic) SmarTrip cards from individuals or non-official sellers.

Customers may lose money by falling victim to discount fare card scams. The transit authority routinely deactivates SmarTrip cards that are purchased fraudulently and then sold to the public for less.



SmarTrip cards are available for sale around the region, including dispensers at all Metrorail stations, at Metro Sales Offices, and through licensed vendors including CVS, Giant, Safeway, and Walmart. Any card purchased from an individual or unlicensed source is considered invalid and can be deactivated.

Here are some SmarTrip security tips:

- Only purchase SmarTrip cards at authorized locations. This includes Metrorail stations, CVS, Giant, Safeway and Walmart.
- Do not purchase a SmarTrip card from online auction websites.
- Never purchase a used SmarTrip card from another person or unauthorized dealer.
- Register your card online in order to protect its value.
- If your SmarTrip card is lost or stolen, report it to the proper authorities immediately.
