February Motorist Complaints on the Rise – A Red Light for January/February Complaints

During the past month we have received an unusual amount of motorist complaints. Below is a list of those complaints.

January 24th – A motorist emailed complaining they witnessed Van 11 traveling at dangerous speeds on 95 South.

January 25th – A motorist called complaining that Van 18 was traveling at high speeds while weaving in and out of traffic along 95 South. This event was witnessed around exit 126.

February 15th – A woman called complaining Van 25 cut her off twice on Fort Belvoir.

February 16th – A man called claiming Van 11 ran through a stop sign on Catlin Ave. turning right onto Russell Road. Also, the motorist complained that the driver cut him off while he was transitioning to the speed limit.

February 16th – We received a call that Van 7 was switching lanes and cutting off other motorist.

All complaints have been forwarded on to their respective vans. We publish these complaints as a reminder to all drivers that safety is our number one concern. As you travel to and from work each day please keep in mind that the safety of your van's passengers and the safety of everyone on the road could be compromised by your aggressive driving. One of the callers voiced his strong concern because he felt the actions of our driver put his pregnant wife in danger. On another note we do appreciate all of our drivers that make safety a priority.
