

### Tougher Penalties for Drivers Who Text

If you are one of those drivers that don't take texting and emailing while driving seriously you may want to think again. On July 1<sup>st</sup> a new law was put into place that will provide tougher penalties for drivers in Virginia who text or email while behind the wheel. This new law increases the fines and makes texting and emailing while driving a primary offense. This means officers can now pull drivers over who they suspect are using their phones to send texts and emails. Prior to this law taking effect, officers needed another reason to pull the vehicle over before charging the driver with distracted driving.

The fines go up significantly: \$125 for the first violation and it doubles to \$250 for subsequent violations.

#### Metro launches new Twitter feeds

On July 10<sup>th</sup> Metro introduced three new Twitter feeds to better meet the needs of their customers.



Service information for Metrorail and Metrobus has moved off of WMATA's main Twitter account (@wmata) into two separate feeds -- @metrorailinfo and @metrobusinfo -- with service information from Metro's operations control centers via the MetroAlerts system. By separating the feeds, riders can follow the accounts that interest them and reduce the number of Metro-related tweets they receive. Metro's main Twitter feed @wmata will continue to carry general information, including news releases, major announcements, new initiatives, and destination promotions.
