
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Are You Helping to Keep Pedestrians Safe While You Are Driving?

In 2015, 5,376 pedestrians died in crashes nationwide. This is a 9.5 percent increase from the previous year. In addition, about 65,000 pedestrians were injured.



There may be several reasons for the increased pedestrian toll. With economic conditions getting better and gas prices low, more people are driving. Another reason for the increase may be the use of smartphones by drivers and people on foot.

All of us have been a pedestrian at some point. While making our commute we should make sure we are extra careful to watch out for pedestrians, especially in the early morning hours where visibility may be minimal. Here are a few tips that can help:

- Stop for pedestrians at crosswalks and be careful when passing stopped vehicles.
- Slow down and obey the posted speed limit.
- Yield to pedestrians & bicyclists when turning.

The Street Smart Campaign began in 2002 to raise awareness and promote enforcement of pedestrian and bicycle safety laws. The goals of the Street Smart campaign include reducing pedestrian and cyclist injuries and deaths, educating drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists about safe use of roadways, and increasing enforcement of pedestrian and bicycle safety laws.
