Interstate 95 Corridor Improvement Plan Public Comment Opportunity

The Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) will study Interstate 95 (I-95) to initiate a study to develop the I-95 Corridor Plan. This plan will identify key problem areas along the corridor and identify potential solutions and areas for additional review and study.

As directed the study team will identify targeted improvements and incident management strategies for the corridor.

Feedback provided by members of communities, industries, and other stakeholders will be considered. Team members plan to study the corridor throughout the summer and prepare a draft plan report in the fall. The findings will be reported to the General Assembly prior to the opening of session in January 2020.

How is Your Vanpool Etiquette?

- Follow your individual vanpool's agreed upon practices. This may vary by van but can be discussed with your fellow riders. You may want to agree upon topics such as eating food, coffee, perfume/cologne usage, and radio choices.
- When you are driving make sure you are driving safely. Don't put others at risk by speeding or aggressive driving.
- Don't make a habit of being late.
- Stay away from controversial topics such as religion or politics unless you know your vanpoolers very well. While some people may enjoy discussing or debating these issues, other may prefer a quieter commute.
- Avoid lengthy cell phone conversations while you are in the van pool.

Remember good etiquette takes into account communication, courtesy, and the safety of everyone in the vanpool.
