Vandalism at Commuter Lots

Recently, we received the following notice from Stafford County:



It has been brought to our attention that vans have been vandalized this week at the Route 17 Commuter lot in Stafford County. Vandals have stolen gasoline from one vanpool by punching / drilling a hole in the gas tank and attempted to cut a gas line in another. Please be aware of this and instruct your passengers to look around the van carefully before boarding the vehicle. Please report all incidents to the Stafford County Sherriff's Department. This occurred last year at the Rt. 630 lot in Stafford County and the thieves were apprehended. Below is a link to the Sherriff's Office.

Here are a couple of tips for you to keep in mind in order to discourage vandalism on your van:

- Park under a streetlight.
- Do not park side-by-side with another van- it gives vandals a place to hide.
- Park so the left side or the gas cap side of the van is clearly visible to the most high-traffic area (usually a storefront).

Vanpool Safety Tips

It is important every now and then to remind ourselves of some basic vanpool safety tips. Here are just a couple to review:



Make sure you are traveling at a safe following distance:

- A van's height obstructs the view for drivers behind you. You need to provide ample following distance because the motorist behind you cannot see traffic issues developing ahead.
- When you are in a full van the additional weight requires more breaking time. Vans don't respond well to abrupt steering and you must take that into consideration.

Always consider where you are boarding and exiting the van:

- Try to find well lit areas that are protected from traffic.
- When loading your van, everyone should fill the front seats first to reduce the rearward shift of the vehicle's center of gravity.

Use caution when changing lanes:

- Vans are longer and wider than cars, you must take this into consideration when changing lanes.
- Use your mirrors, appropriate head turns, and the assistance of other passengers to check your blind spots frequently.

Ensure you are properly prepared to drive:

 Familiarize yourself with your route and alternatives in the case of accidents or road work.

- Fatigue has been is a leading contributor to accidents. If you feel tired pull off the road and ask another driver to take your place.
- Avoid medications that are sedatives or may cause you to have impaired judgment.

- Using cellphones while driving a van is strictly prohibited.
