Safe Driving Tips for the 4th of July

We know many of you will be heading out for road trips, long weekends, and enjoying time spent with family and friends during our upcoming Fourth of July weekend. Here are a couple of tips to keep you safe as you travel.



- Don't drink and drive. Of the 400+ fatalities over the Fourth of July weekend every year, 40%-60% are due to drunk driving. Make sure you have a designated driver— someone who will not drink a drop of alcohol before driving home from the fireworks and festivities.
- Make sure to get enough sleep. The second cause of driving fatalities is drowsiness. With all the festivities it is easy to party and stay up late. If you are tired pull over and rest.
- Look out for other drivers who may be impaired or distracted. If you spot a vehicle obviously endangering others (swerving, switching lanes erratically, etc.) maintain a safe following distance and don't attempt to pass them. When you feel you are no longer in danger ask another passenger in your vehicle to report the car (via drivers' license number) by calling your local nonemergency police line.
