The 395 Express Lanes are coming this November

Starting in November, the I-395 HOV lanes will become Express Lanes. Thanks to the 95 Express Lanes, most HOV customers along the I-95/I-395 corridor are familiar with how to use Express Lanes and already have an E-ZPass® Flex.

But to ensure an easy transition here are a couple of things you need to know:

- The 395 Express Lanes will extend 8 miles from near Edsall Road in Fairfax County to the 14th Street Bridge near Washington D.C.
- Just like the 95 and 495 Express Lanes, the 395 Express Lanes will use dynamic tolls and be free for HOV-3+ vehicles with an E-ZPass® Flex set to "HOV ON." The rules will apply 24/7.

- The Seminary Road south ramp will remain HOV-only at all times.

Pentagon commuters can expect to gain quicker access to the Pentagon and Pentagon City by improvements to the Eads Street interchange. For those who drop off carpool passengers near the Pentagon or Pentagon City, to avoid disruptions to carpooling in the I-395 corridor and give commuters another great reason to try HOV-3 travel, carpooler drivers will go free to DC, even if they drop off their passengers on Eads Street. Here's how it will work:

1. A driver carools on the northbound 395 Express Lanes with their Flex in HOV Mode and exits the Lanes at Eads Street to drop off passengers at the Pentagon or Pentagon City.
2. The driver then sets the Flex to toll mode and gets back on the northbound Lanes from Eads Street.
3. Since the technology on the Lanes will know the vehicle was just carpooling a short time earlier, the driver won't be charged a toll for the last part of their trip.

Drivers should put their Flex in toll mode to avoid getting pulled over by Virginia State Police troopers who will enforce for cheaters.

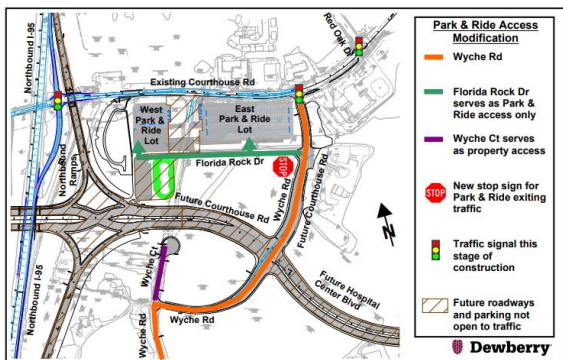

Changes to the Stafford County Courthouse Road Park & Ride Lot

Access to the Route 630 (Courthouse Road) Park & Ride commuter lot in Stafford County changed on Wednesday, Oct. 16, as a new side entrance to the lot opens from Wyche Road.

Florida Rock Drive will serve as the only entrance and exit to the Park & Ride lot until construction is complete in July 2020. Construction is underway to build a larger lot with additional parking and new amenities as part of the Interstate 95 Exit 140 interchange reconstruction project.

As the new lot entrance opens at Florida Rock Drive, the temporary traffic signal at the existing lot entrance on Courthouse Road will be turned off. A temporary traffic signal will be placed in full color operation at the Courthouse Road and Wyche Road intersection.

Construction on the \$195 million project to reconfigure Exit 140 to a diverging diamond interchange began in July 2017. The project is also widening Courthouse Road to four lanes from Route 1 to just west of Ramoth Church Road and Winding Creek Road. When construction is finished, there will be approximately 1,100 commuter parking spaces available at the Exit 140 interchange

carpool and vanpool pickup and drop-off area to assist with HOV ridesharing. The finished lots will have multiple entrances, sidewalks, shelters, bicycle racks, and permanent lighting structures.
